In BHS Awaé Yaoundé, we witnessed in a practical way the Scripture that say, "all things work for good" (Romans 8:28). We faced a huge challenge to manage the discipleship load on the campus because of lack of ministers every Saturday. We want to praise God for using this to stretch us to see ministry on the campus in a different way. We have been able to engage senior students who have been discipled to start teaching the younger ones. We thank God that most of these older students are leading some of the classes and this is also helping them to grow their capacity to lead.



During Spiritual emphasis on the campuses we serve, God gives us unique opportunities to share our faith with students one-on-one. The beginning of this academic year has been exceptional with BHS Buea and BHS Awaé. We had the opportunity to counsel more two hundred students on the days of the spiritual emphasis and the weeks that followed. In BHS Buea for example the team witness students who said yes to Jesus and got interested immediately in discipleship. Only God can do something like this with the prevailing evil in our society and the peer pressure on school campuses. Praise God for the harvest !

One of the outstanding blessing we have received as we minister on campuses is the support from the school administration. Favour Bilingual Comprehensive School Bafang is one of such school with the proprietress always in support to our ministry to the students.
